PERMISSION TO DISTRIBUTE GCSAusE DATA THROUGH TALKBANK Carnegie Mellon University

For the program to function properly, many contributors will be asked to and will give permission for their work to be made available to other researchers. This contribution is subject to these further restrictions:

- 1. CMU will acknowledge Griffith as the owner/copyright-holder of the Dataset, including IP rights.
- 2. CMU will make the audio recordings available only to scholars and other responsible parties through a password system. The transcripts will be made freely available as per normal Talkbank practices.
- 3. The right of CMU to distribute the Dataset through Talkbank will be withdrawn if people are charged to access the Dataset. Otherwise, the right to disseminate the Dataset is perpetual, unless Griffith chooses to terminate this agreement (which it may do so at any time, by giving CMU notice in writing).

Griffith will indemnify and render harmless both Brian MacWhinney and Carnegie Mellon University against any actions at law or in equity or in similar courts of any jurisdictions arising from Griffith's breach of this agreement.
